CHILD PROTECTION UNIT FOR GRADES TK-4

Mariposa Safe Families is helping to make our school even more safe and supportive. Starting on February 16th, a representative from this organization will be teaching six weekly lessons from the *Second Step* Child Protection unit to students in grades TK-4. In this unit, students learn three types of safety: personal safety, touching safety, and assertiveness. A Parent/Guardian Information Night is scheduled for Thursday, January 26th at 6PM in the Multi-purpose Room. This event will provide parents/guardians with the opportunity to review the curriculum and ask questions about the content of the unit.
