ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY:

It is further agreed that the undersigned is fully aware of the nature and extent of the potential hazards of an Inflatable Bounce House, and agrees that Sierra Foothill Charter School shall not be responsible or liable for any and all injuries sustained by my child, or for any loss, damage, or expense arising out of this activity. In the event of personal injury or illness, I/we are responsible for such costs, damages, and expenses.

With respect to my child's participation in this activity/event, I/we release, hold harmless and waive all claims against Sierra Foothill Charter School, its officers, agents, employees, volunteers; the Authorizing School District; and the State of California without regard to negligence.
