On 11/8/22, California voters approved Proposition 28: The Arts and Music in Schools (AMS) Funding Guarantee and Accountability Act. This required the state to establish a new, ongoing program supporting arts instruction in schools beginning in 2023-24. The legislation allocates 1 percent of the K-12 portion of the Proposition 98 funding guarantee provided in the prior fiscal year, excluding funding appropriated for the AMS education program.
